


R & D Management and Coordination

- The group also discussed the implementation of the banning of single use plastic in the SUCs and the initiatives of DIDP and ARDEC on the same issue


Joint Consortia Secretariat Meeting on the Submission of Regional Collaborative Program proposal for 2023-2025
